### From Bécancour, Qc to Manchester, N.H.

## Alphonse Levasseur 1876-1936 (Adéline Bouchard) Descendant of the ancestor Pierre Levasseur

Iphonse Levasseur was born on August 26, 1876, in Bécancour, Nicolet, Quebec. He was the second child of Jean Levasseur (born July 17, 1848) and Blandine Hamel (born February 17, 1856). He had five brothers: Amédée Levasseur (born September 29, 1874), Eugène Philogène Levasseur (born September 7, 1878), Gédéon Edmond Adélard Levasseur (born December 29, 1882), Delphis Levasseur (born August 6, 1885), and Adolphe William "Willie" Levasseur (born January 21, 1888), as well as five sisters: Joseph Alfred Frady Levasseur (born November 13, 1880), Albertine Angelina Levasseur (born September 17, 1890), Clarilda Levasseur (born March 7, 1892), Aurore Levasseur (born January 26, 1894), and Émilia Levasseur (born around 1896).

Alphonse was 39 years old when his mother, Blandine Hamel, passed away on July 16, 1916, and 52 years old when his father, Jean Levasseur, passed away on April 17, 1929.

On October 8, 1897, at the age of 21, he married Adéline Bouchard, who was also 21 years old at the time. She was born on June 1, 1876, in Manchester, St. Mary, New Hampshire. Together, they had eleven children: Marie-Louise Levasseur (born October 31, 1898), Yvonne Levasseur (born April 3, 1900), Blanche Levasseur (born September 1, 1901), Josaphat Levasseur (born January 20, 1903), Marie-Ange Levasseur (born May 8, 1905), Denise Levasseur (born February 19, 1907), Ernestine Levasseur (born February 16, 1909), Lionel Levasseur (born November 16, 1911), Théodore Levasseur (born November 15, 1913), Albert Levasseur (see the next generation) (born March 15, 1916), and Émile Levasseur (born September 16, 1918). Alphonse Levasseur passed away on May 18, 1936, in Montreal, Quebec, at the age of 59. He was buried in Longue-Pointe, Montreal, on May 20, 1936. His wife, Adéline Bouchard, had passed away three years earlier, on May 14, 1933.




## Second generation



lbert Levasseur was born on March 15, 1916, in Grand-Mère, QC. Albert was 17 years old when his mother, Adéline Bouchard, passed away on May 14, 1933. He was 20 when his father, Alphonse Levasseur, passed on May 18, 1936. On February 18, 1936, he married Bibiane Bélanger in Montreal, QC. Together, they had ten children: Fernand Levasseur, Jacques Levasseur, Réal Levasseur, André Levasseur, Monique Levasseur, Denis Levasseur, Doris Levasseur, Louise Levasseur, Raymond Levasseur, and Guy Levasseur.

Albert passed away on October 17, 1987, in Arthabaska, QC, at the age of 71. His wife, Bibiane Bélanger, passed away 19 years later, on July 6, 2006.


#### Alphonse Levasseur 1876-1936 (1)

- Wedding on <u>6 novembre 1897</u> Manchester, N.H. (21 years old)
  - Marriage certificate celebrated in Manchester, NH.
  - Occupation: Driver (driver)
- Manchester, N.H. 1900 National census
  - He lives at 43, Marion St. Manchester, N.H.
  - The Levasseur-Bouchard couple lives in the residence of their father-in-law, Alexis Bouchard.
  - Alphonse is 24 years old at this time
- Around 1903 until 1916, he was found in Grand-Mère, Qc, where 7 children of the couple were born.
- In 1910. Manchester. N.H. 1910 (National Census) (34 years)
  - He lives on Douglas St, Manchester, N.H.
  - Profession: Building painter
  - Tenant
- Return to Grandmother in 1916 Birth of Albert Levasseur Albert Levasseur's baptism certificate
- Around 1918, place of residence, Macamic en Abitibi, Qc. Birth of Émile
- Return to Quebec Royal-Roussillon, Abitibi 1er juin 1921 Canada Census (45 years)
  - Profession: Cultivator
  - Eight children live in the residence.
  - Albert, Guillaume's grandfather, is five years old.
