Note from the webmaster:

We very much hope that this initiative by Gilles will inspire you to send us old photographs and obituaries of your family. You will understand that the help of all the Levasseurs and Carmels is essential to complete this project that aims to link the maximum number of records in our database to documents described in this article by Gilles Carmel. In our opinion, few or no family associations are fortunate to have a team of volunteers who work so hard to ensure the recording of documents for the benefit of future generations. Please take a few minutes in advance to rummage through your boxes of old documents and photos and submit copies to be recorded in your personnel archives ⁽¹⁾. If you cannot produce electronic versions of these documents, please mail them to us and they will be returned to you prepaid

A major project

I have undertaken a major project that has taken considerable work in recent months to integrate new documents into the website's database. Beyond simply entering personal information of our Levasseur and Carmel families, we felt it was particularly important to complete all these files by adding photos or other documents, transmitted by our members or found as a result of our searches on the Internet.

For example, I have inserted photographs, obituaries, mortuary maps and bookmarks of our deceased in the "Obituaries/Obituaries" section of our database processing site⁽³⁾. More than a thousand images have already been downloaded; hundreds more will be added in the coming months.

At this rate, in a short time, we will be able to link tens of thousands of photos or documents to the name of persons listed on the database website. Most of the time, these images will be linked to a person.

When the databases are updated (twice a year), new records compiled by our genealogist, Joceline Levasseur, will be added to the site. We invite you to provide us with information using the genealogical collection form on our website⁽⁴⁾.

Help us complete the missing information

Certain obituaries can be problematic. For example, the text at times refers to a Levasseur or Carmel as grandson (daughter) or stepson or daughter-in-law and we are unable to establish a connection. When this happens and is displayed, you will see next to the name in parentheses, the link of that person with a Levasseur.

You will then notice that there is no mention of a link to a personal file.

By clicking on the name, you will see the full image and obituary.

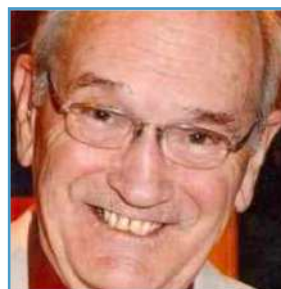
