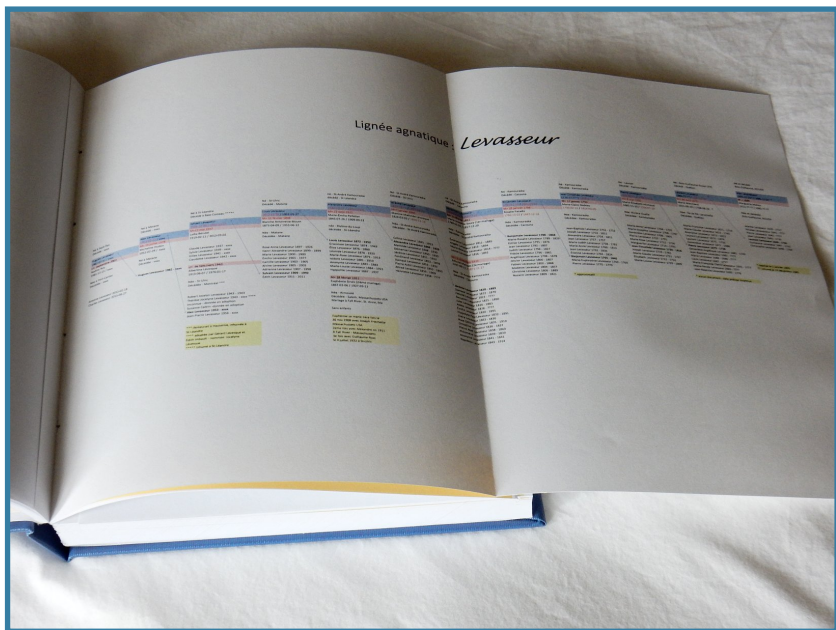
The book:

“The idea came to me to write this book in order to leave my son and my two grandsons this information in a clear format that exclusively discusses their origin. Not only regarding the paternal line of Levasseur, but also about many other families who are in their genealogical line. Therefore I traced the lines of seven families, going back as far as each European ancestor and telling their respective histories, the places when they came, and without forgetting to highlight all four grandparents of my beloved children. The book also is replete with many illustrations. »

“The second part of the book is devoted to the reproduction of our ancestors’ official documents, such as copies of parish records of baptisms, marriages and funerals, and also certain civil actions. These are important to ensure the corrections of the genealogical lines.”.

This book is a product of almost two years of work, from the research to the author’s self-publishing. Only six copies were printed.

My name is Alex Levasseur ⁽¹⁾, a ninth-generation descendant of Laurent Levasseur. I’ve worked 36 years as a journalist for Canadian public broadcasting ([CBC](#)). This is my second published book.
